Sunday Morning

- **Nursery**—Clean, safe, baby-friendly environment where infants and toddlers are introduced to Jesus.
- **Preschool**—Fun, creative, interactive program that introduces preschoolers to small groups and corporate worship.
- **Elementary**—Age-appropriate, kid-friendly teaching with creative activities designed to enhance the lesson.
- **Worship**—In addition to the small group format of the classes, preschool through 4th grade children gather for 20 minutes of worship. Fifth and sixth graders worship together with parents until they are dismissed to their classes.

Communion Sunday

The first Sunday each month, K-6th graders join their parents for worship at the Edmonds Center for the Arts. Children's bulletins are provided to enhance the children's worship experience.

AWANA Clubs

"The goal and purpose of Awana is that all children and youth will come to know, love, and serve the Lord Jesus Christ." Clubs meet on all non-holiday Mondays, from September through May, from 6:30-8:15 pm.

Christmas Musical

Children rehearse a musical, worship God, serve others, memorize verses and enjoy friends. Practices are held on Sunday mornings in the Fall from 8:30-9:15 am.

Records are kept of salvation decisions and children and parents are contacted with an offer to attend a discipleship class and receive helpful materials for growth. Children are supported with consistent follow-up and prayer.
