



DISCIPLE-MAKING ADVENTURE



1 Invite a trusted Christian friend to help you look at the life of Jesus and help you understand how to become a Christian.

Attend a church that teaches the Bible and ask Jesus to make himself real to you.



2 Begin a daily quiet time, spending time with Jesus in His Word and in prayer. Share what you are learning with others.

Spend time with Jesus in worship and small group.

Ask a Christian friend to help you talk about what you are learning from worship, small group, and your personal time with Jesus.



3 Cultivate relationships with lost friends. Look for opportunities to turn everyday conversations into gospel conversations, and invite them to put their trust in Jesus. Learn how to answer basic questions about Christ and the Bible.
